I like this type as it has a hand written feel to it but is also quite bold.




I like the swirls of the emblem and how they don't effect the text that is cropped by the shape of a circle

I like the use of the dark outlined pattern on the circle which contrast against the white centre.




I like the pale colours that are used in the illustration

I like the contrast between the sharp harsh toned lines of the flowers against the dull toned smooth lines of the circle and type.




I like the use of two different type in the circle, it creates a sense of balance.

I don't like the unfinished look of these flowers with the rest of this particular design.




I like the idea of the shadow behind the circle as it provides an element of 3D.

I like the scale of the type around the edges of the circle and I also like the type its self.




I like the idea of the leaves that have a dark shadow behind it, as they look as though are falling.



I feel that the leaves should be smaller than they are.


I like the faded outout as it provides contrast against the darker tones of the background and the sanserif type.

I like the subtle serif text used, which contrasts against the thick bold lines that surround it.


I like the use of two lines to outline the category word 'FASHION'.

I love the way the word 'fashion' has been cropped by the center circle.


I love the use of watercolour paints in this design. The blotchy mixture of colours is an element I like.



I'm not a huge fan of having a faded opacity flower (Rose) as the background to the type.

I don't like that the type used is all the same sanserif.

I like the cropping effect of the piece created by the smaller dripping circle in the centre of the larger scaled circle.



I'm not too sure about the use of green in my logo. I feel as though they would have to have a low opacity in order to work well.

I don't like the imbalance that is created by having a circle inside a circle.

I don't like the use of pale colours inside the smaller circle. I feel that the circle should just be a plain black or white.

I feel as though the watercolour used is a little bright for the look I had intended, and would need to have the opacity lowered.

I like the dripping effect of the circle, as it creates a nice imbalance.

I like the bold sanserif type of "LACI" and how it is aligned with the centre of the logo creating a good balance.



I like the incorporation of a fluffy textured leaf with the flowers as it helps to break it up a little.

I like the use of a large white circle around a smaller dark toned circle as they contrast against each other creating a hierarchy drawing your eye to the smaller illustrated circle.

I like the idea of the flowers just being a rough outline as it creates a hand drawn feel.


I like that the flowers are off centre within the circle as it creates an imbalance in the design which works for this design.

I think that the use of multiple organic shaped roses takes away from the elegance of a single rose.



I love the large blob of watercolour in this design. It helps to create a hierarchy and to contrast against the solid black organic lines of the rose.

I like the small grainy texture in the watercolour created by a piece of paper towel when the paint was wet.




I feel that the only down side to this design would be that due to the vibrant colours used and the boldness of the deep black lines the type would become lost.

I don't like the overall look of this design. I feel this is due to the placement of the roses, they seem to form a line rather than create the effect that they are floating away.

I think that the type becomes lost as a result of the repeating shape of the rose, creating a leading line, leading your eye away from the type.

The combination of colours works really well and has created a nice organic shape in the process.


The use of subtle silver and gold circles help to highlight the black sanserif type that has been used, this is an element I like.

I feel as though the overall colours are too bright.


I would have liked the design to have more black even just in

I don't like the placement of the serif type, however I do like the particular type chosen for this design




I don't like the dark colours used in this design as I feel it gives a depressing vibe.

I don't feel as though the type in this design has been used in an effective way, as it's so small + difficult to read.




I like the pastel colours used to create a hierarchy within the piece.

I don't like the placement of the type, nor do I like the type itself.


I don't like the inner design as I feel it is too tropical for the target audience.
